

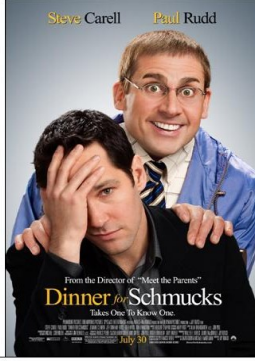

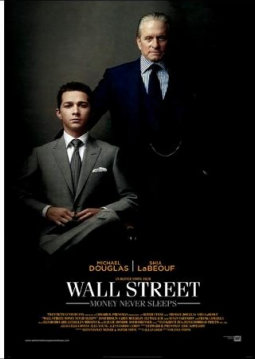

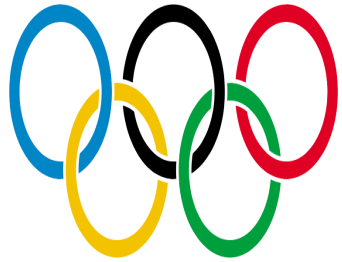
Family Fun Nights

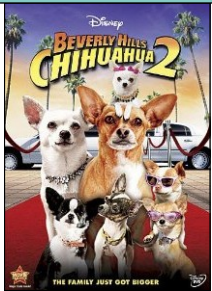

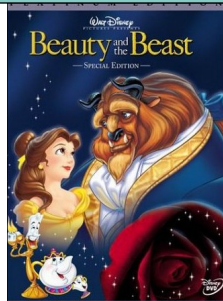
