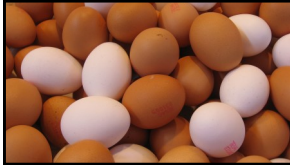


Just 4 Tweens for grades 3-5

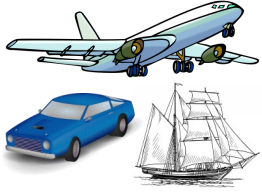
The Library will provide straws and connectors with which kids and families can build fabulous structures.

Build It With Boxes 3:00 Drive – In Movie

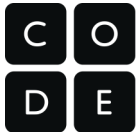
Between 2:00 and 3:00 build a car out of boxes. Then “drive” your car in to watch a movie beginning at 3:00.

Sign Up for Reading Program - This is your first opportunity to register for the Summer Reading Program. We have programs available for all ages!

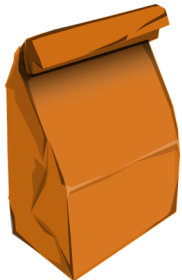
Entertainment - There will be various entertainers and activities throughout the event including a presentation about monarch butterflies by Richard Breen.
